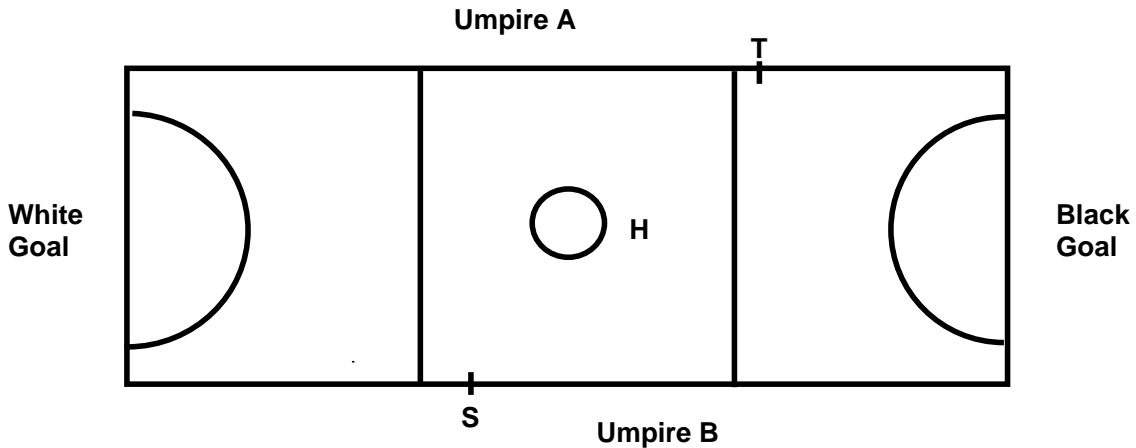

(b) The ball goes out of Court behind the Goal Line at Black's goal end. In order to get into a better position for the Throw In, White C runs across the Goal Circle.

This Section has **ten** questions. Each question is worth **3 marks**.

In this Section, some questions require you to “name the infringement/s”. If no infringement has occurred, answer “No infringement”. Similarly if you are asked to state the umpire’s action/s, a possible answer may be “let play continue”. Remember to state **where** a penalty is to be taken.

Where you are asked to explain an answer, it is important you provide additional information to that given in an earlier part of the question. You should also indicate whenever the **first** of two infringements is to be penalised or when the Advantage Rule is to be applied.

3/1 White’s Centre Pass is caught by Black GD with feet astride the transverse line. Black GD passes the ball to Black GA standing just outside the Goal Circle. Black GA turns quickly, steps into the Goal Circle and successfully shoots for goal.

3/5 White GS takes a Penalty Shot after Contact by Black GK near the Goalpost. White GA stands 0.7 m in front of White GS, making it difficult for Black GD to defend. Black GD leans across White GA to defend the shot and pushes GA off balance.
